Refunds, less a 25% administrative fee will be made if cancellations are received in writing, **up to six weeks before the event**. Any cancellations received after this time will not be eligible for a refund. We regret, refund for failure to attend cannot be made but you can transfer your event fee, minus a 25% administrative fee, to a future event within 12 months.
